

NEGLECT OF PRAYER IS EXPENSIVE

"You desire but do not have, so you kill. You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God" James 4:2



he above scripture reveals a profound truth about the human condition. We often struggle and strive to get what we want, but we neglect the most important thing: prayer. Today, many people are crying, complaining, and frustrated with life. They are wondering why their lives are not changing, why their businesses are not growing, why they are not getting the opportunities they desire. But God's answer to all these questions and cries is simple: neglect of prayer.

A businessman or woman may wonder why their business is not growing, despite doing everything they know to do but God still answers, "neglect of prayer." A young person may hope and long for a scholarship or bursary to further their education, but God's answer is the same: "neglect of prayer." We have not what we want because we do not ask God. The secret behind all our struggles is grossly displayed by our lack of seriousness in spiritual matters. We know that prayer is powerful, but we still struggle to spend quality time in prayer. What is holding us back? What is it that even after knowing the power of prayer, we still neglect to pray?
